WCCU will be holding the **86th Annual Meeting on April 24, 2024 at the Williston Area Recreation Center (ARC) at 6:00 PM (CT).** Registration will begin at 5:30 PM (CT).

Gabriel Dobbs

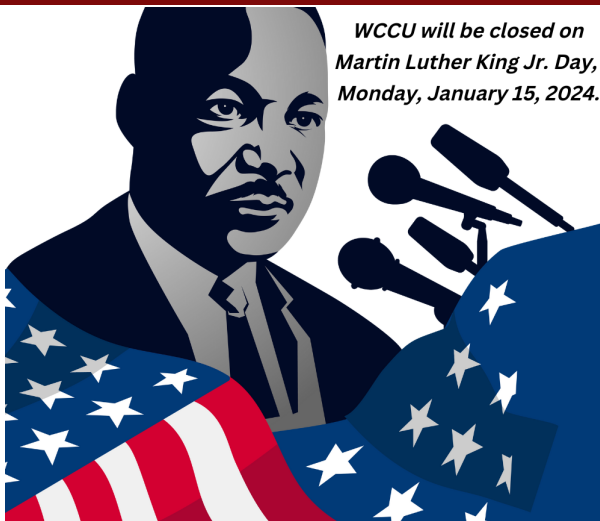
