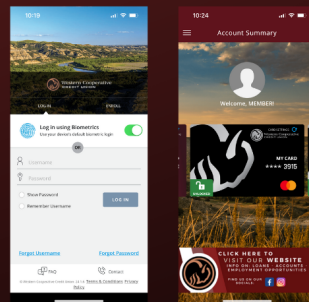
The MobiMoney App is no longer linked to any WCCU Transactions or accounts as of Monday, October 3, 2022.
