Hope Merritt

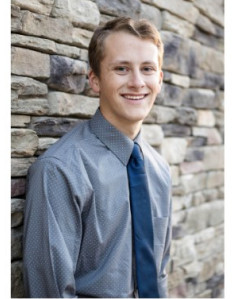
